

Q & A - CONTACT LENS COURSE FOR OPTICIANS

Q: Who is eligible to join this Course?

A: All the candidates that have received the notification letter from MOC (Malaysian Optical Council) can take this course.

Candidates must be a registered Optician with MOC.

Q: If I have passed the theory and failed the practical exam previously, can I apply for practical training only?

A: Can, considering the time frame otherwise just enrol for the practical training.

Q: What is the course structure?

A: Course – 120 hours with 46 theory hours and 74 practical hours

Upon completion of the hours, there will be a theory and practical examination conducted internally by NIOS before the Certificate of completion is given.

Q: Where is the venue for the course?

A: At National Institute of Ophthalmic Sciences (NIOS)

Q: What is the schedule for this course?

A: This is a part time course and the theory will be conducted from March 2017 (7 consecutive days). Practical sessions will be conducted in April 2017 (7 consecutive days).

The schedule will be given with teaching materials on first day of theory class.

Q: What is the course fee?

A: Full course - RM7,500.00

Only practical training - RM5,000.00

Q: What is the mode of payment?

A: Credit card/Online transaction/Cash/Easy payment

Q: What will I achieve after the course?

A: After completing the examinations, the Candidates will be granted the Certificate of Course Completion. With this certificate, the Candidate can register with the MOC and sit for the examination to obtain the 'pink' certificate.

Q: When is the examination by MOC?

A: In July 2017
